The Addictions Therapy Training Institute (ATTI) was created to train those individuals interested in becoming certified as addiction service providers. Classes begin on February 12th, 2016.



ATTI is an approved educational provider for the Florida Certification Board (FCB) #5094-A. FCB certifies addiction specialists, counselors and professionals. ATTI currently provides the educational requirements for licensed interns and therapists who wish to sit for the certification exam. (Please go to <u>www.FLCertificationBoard.org</u> for more information.) These courses fall under the category of "Transdisciplinary Foundations."

ATTI offers a 10-month program, with 8-hour classes held once a month on the second Friday. Participants will also need to complete 8 hours per month of independent study work for a total of 160 educational hours.

Included in this program are Domestic Violence, Ethics, and HIV/AIDS education.

All classes may be attended in person or by internet from anywhere in the world. The cost of the program is \$2,400, payable in monthly installments if preferred. Go to the <u>Registration</u> page to register for the Spring 2016 program.

The answer: Water and air.


